SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The School Board derives its authority to govern the local schools directly from the Wisconsin Constitution and the state statutes. The District is classified as a common school district and the Board shall govern it accordingly.

Number of Board Members

The Board shall consist of nine members representing the following areas:

- The City of Juneau and the Town of Oak Grove – four members
- The Village of Clyman, the Town of Clyman, and the Town of Hustisford – one member
- The Village of Lowell, the Town of Lowell, and the Town of Beaver Dam – two members
- The Village of Reeseville and the Town of Shields – one member
- One member at large from any city, town or village within the boundaries of the district

Board members shall take office on the fourth Monday in April following their election to the Board.

Terms of Office

Board members shall serve for a term of three years and/or until their successors are elected and qualified.
