BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

Any person is legally qualified to become a member of the School Board who is a United States Citizen and a qualified elector of the school district.

In addition, it would be desirable that members of the School Board have a genuine interest in and devotion to public education, a willingness to give time and effort to the work, a capacity for understanding people, and the ability to work cooperatively with others.

Candidates must have filed the Declaration of Candidacy in compliance with Wisconsin Statutes.
