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NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

The School Board and the administrative staff shall make every effort to assist each newly elected or appointed member in becoming fully informed about the functions, policies, and procedures and concerns of the Board before taking office. The following methods shall be employed:

1. The elected or appointed member shall be given materials available relating to Board powers, duties, and responsibilities.
2. The elected or appointed member shall be invited to attend Board meetings.
3. The District Administrator or designee shall supply materials pertinent to meetings and shall explain their use.
4. Newly elected or appointed Board members shall be invited to meet with the District Administrator, other administrative personnel, and existing members of the Board to discuss responsibilities.
