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SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

A special Board meeting may be called upon the request of any member of the School Board and shall be noticed in accordance with state law. The District Administrator has been designated to provide the required notification to Board members and to the public of the time and place of the special Board meeting at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. Such notice shall be in writing and shall be delivered to each board member personally or by leaving written notice at the Board member's usual abode, setting forth the time and place of said meeting. A special Board meeting may be held without prior notice if all Board Members are present and consent, or if every Board member consents in writing even though he/she does not attend.

No business shall be transacted at the special Board meeting other than that specified in the notification thereof.

Special school district meetings shall be held in accordance with state law.
