RECOGNITION FOR ACCOMPLISHMENT

The School Board wishes to recognize excellence and outstanding achievement by individuals or groups in all areas of the school program. The Board shall recognize and commend such outstanding achievements as:

1. Outstanding service and leadership to the District and the community.
2. Offices held and professional assignments completed in educational-related activities.
3. Honors received for outstanding performances.
4. Recognition deemed appropriate by the Board.

The administration, staff, public and/or the Board members may make recommendations for recognition and commendation. All recommendations shall be made through the District Administrator, designee, or Board President.
