RECRUITMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR

When a district administrative position becomes open, the School Board shall aggressively recruit in an effort to fill the position with the most capable person available. The Board shall consider only those candidates who meet both state and local qualifications and who display the ability to successfully perform the essential duties of the District Administrator.

The Board shall inform various placement agencies of the vacancy in administration. The Board, as a whole, shall select and appoint the District Administrator at a legally held regular or special meeting of the Board. A majority vote of the Board shall be required.
