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CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND ADOPTION

The Dodgeland School Board recognizes the importance of continuous review and modification of the curriculum in order to meet the changing needs of students and improve teaching and learning. The District's curriculum shall be in line with the state academic standards adopted by the Board and applicable state law requirements.

Professional staff, under the direction and supervision of the District Administrator, along with the Curriculum Committee, shall be delegated the responsibility for continuously proposing and developing curriculum changes and additions. Each major curricular area shall be reviewed at least once every five (5) years.

Communication and coordination among grade level and subject area teachers should be emphasized on a pre-kindergarten through grade 12 basis whenever curriculum is developed.

All subject area offerings and any additions or deletions to the curriculum shall be reviewed and adopted by the Board before they are initiated or dropped from the existing program of instruction.
