GUIDELINES FOR PARENT INVOLVEMENT (TITLE I)

The Dodgeland School District shall provide opportunities for parents/guardians to participate in the design and implementation of the Title I program, and to be involved in the academic achievement of their children. Activities shall include, but not be limited to the following:

As students are identified for participation in the Title I program, parents/guardians shall be contacted by letter and/or telephone regarding how and why their child was selected for the program. In addition, each student's parents/guardians shall be provided:

1. Information about the specific instructional objectives for the student.
2. Reports about the student's progress in the Title I program at least two times during the school year.
3. Opportunities for regular, meaningful two-way communication with teachers regarding learning standards and student achievement through school-parent compacts, report cards, conferences, meetings, telephone contacts, notes and other appropriate means.
4. Materials and suggestions for helping the student as deemed appropriate by the Title I teacher and Title I director.
5. Training sessions, scheduled by the District, to learn how to help their children.

At least one annual meeting shall be scheduled for parents/guardians to provide timely information concerning the program, to share evaluation results, and to hear suggestions for future planning, development and operation of the program.
