SECTION 504 PLAN

The Dodgeland School District shall provide a free and appropriate public education to each student within its jurisdiction without discrimination because of the student's disability or handicap condition. Reasonable accommodations shall be provided to allow students with disabilities/handicaps to have an equal opportunity to participate in school and school-related activities.

It is the intent of the District to ensure that students with disabilities/handicaps as defined by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 are identified, evaluated and provided with appropriate educational services in accordance with legal requirements and established procedures outlined for the District.

District employees shall comply with this policy and established procedures.

The District Administrator or his/her designee shall be responsible for administering this policy within established administrative procedures. This includes preparation of assurances of compliance, development of all required plans and reports, administration of the established complaint procedure and the operation of the educational program.

This policy shall be implemented and complaints processed accordingly.
