ONLINE LEARNING

Students may enroll in a Wisconsin Virtual School or DodgeLand School District course(s) with prior approval of the building principal or designee. Course enrollment decisions shall be made on an individual basis utilizing the participation and extenuating circumstances guidelines set forth below. Guidelines for participation include, but are not limited to the following:

- College bound students in need of advanced or specialized coursework.
- Credit deficient students needing specific courses in order to graduate.
- Students wanting to improve their skills in specific subject areas.
- Remedial students who require one-on-one support.
- Gifted or advanced students who want expanded educational offerings.
- Summer school students.
- Students with scheduling conflicts.
- Home bound students.
- Students who may not otherwise have a particular offering available.

The District shall grant credit for online courses in accordance with District policies and procedures. Online courses shall be approved for credit by the District consistent with any other form of instructional delivery. Therefore, all District policies related to academic honesty, participation and attendance apply to online courses.

The District shall pay for the first online course enrolled in by a student. If the student successfully completes the course, the District may fund subsequent online courses for the student. If the student does not complete the course successfully and chooses to enroll in other Wisconsin Virtual School or District courses, he/she must provide the tuition fee prior to enrollment and will be reimbursed by the District upon successful completion of the course.

Students shall abide by established rules for participating in online courses and acceptable technology use. Failure to do so shall result in appropriate disciplinary action.
