### EARLY GRADUATION

Graduation from Dodgeland High School may be permitted one semester early with approval of the School Board. Each case will be judged on an individual basis.

Students requesting early graduation must have a plan to fulfill all graduation requirements prior to the anticipated date of early graduation. Students must submit an application at least a semester in advance of this date that includes verification by the counselor and principal that the student will be eligible for early graduation and approval of the parent/guardian if the student is a minor.

When making early graduation decisions, the Board shall review recommendations from the District Administrator, high school principal, school counselor, parents/guardians and other appropriate staff members.

Early graduates may participate in graduation exercises that are held once a year following the second semester. Early graduates shall be eligible for all academic awards and scholarships.
