GRADUATION EXERCISES

Graduation exercises shall be held at the conclusion of each school year for the graduating class. Only students who have completed all graduation requirements and other obligations for graduation, as specified by Board policy and the High School Principal, will be eligible to participate. The High School Principal may waive this restriction for a student in the case of an emergency or other extenuating circumstances. Foreign exchange students attending the high school with senior status may participate in graduation exercises and receive a certificate of attendance if all school requirements have been met and approval is granted by the High School Principal.

The High School Principal shall be responsible for graduation exercises, including establishing acceptable standards of dress. Students participating in graduation exercises must wear the cap and gown selected for the year. The graduation ceremony is a school sponsored activity and therefore, all Board policies and school rules addressing student conduct apply.

The awarding of diplomas shall involve the School Board, District Administrator and High School Principal.
