**HIGH SCHOOL CLASS RANK**

Class rankings shall be maintained starting with the 9<sup>th</sup> grade and continuing through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Only full-time students shall qualify for class ranking status. Semester grades shall be used to calculate grade point average (GPA) for class rank. Class rank shall be updated at the end of each semester.

The grades earned in all courses taken by high school students shall be used in determining GPAs for the purpose of class rank, except as otherwise specifically provided by provisions outlined in District grading policies and procedures.

The grades for high school courses taken by middle school students may be used in determining class rank.

Class ranks of students with senior status at the end of four years of high school enrollment shall only include those students who have met the District's graduation requirements. For seniors approved for early graduation, class ranks shall be part of the calculations for the entire graduating class in accordance with established District procedures.
