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STUDENT FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

The School Board recognizes that student fund raising activities are part of student organizations and extracurricular events. The Board supports fund raising projects that are designed to promote educational and extracurricular activities without interfering with the educational process. The goal of raising and expending funds by student groups shall be for school and school-related purposes, for items outside the budget that enhance the educational program, or for charitable contributions.

All fund raising projects and activities shall have prior permission from the faculty advisor and principal or designee. Funds raised by any student class, club or organization shall be processed through the appropriate financial accounting system and in accordance with district financial policies and procedures.

All student fund raising activities shall be voluntary and in accordance with state law.

All fund raising projects and activities must have prior approval by the District Administrator or designee when students are involved and/or when conducted in the school's or district's name, or on school property. This includes, but is not limited to, adult school-related groups, support groups, and fund raising for charitable organizations.
