**FULL-TIME STUDENTS**

The Dodgeland School Board defines a full-time student, for membership count purposes, as follows:

1. Elementary students in grades 5K – 5 must be scheduled for the full school day program and 4K/Early Childhood students for half-days four days per week to be considered a full-time student.
2. Middle school students must be scheduled for the minimum number of classes as required by the administration to be considered a full-time student. Information regarding the minimum number of classes required may be found in the Dodgeland Middle/High School Student/Parent Handbook.
3. High school students must be enrolled in classes or participating in Board-approved activities during each class period of each school day throughout their high school years. A student must be enrolled in a minimum of seven classes each semester to be considered a full-time student.
4. Students with disabilities may be assigned less than the minimum program or class load and still be considered full-time if prescribed by their individualized educational program (IEP) team.
5. Students enrolled in an alternative educational program, or other program or curriculum modifications approved by the Board, school administration and/or parents/guardians, as required by law, are considered full-time students.
6. Resident students attending public school in other school districts under the full-time public school open enrollment law or a tuition waiver under section 121.84(4) of the state statutes are also considered a full-time students.
