FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Dodgeland School Board encourages participation with organizations that plan and implement programs of student exchange between foreign countries and the District.

The objectives of the foreign exchange program are to:

- assist in the promotion of world-wide understanding;
- further the appreciation of our democratic system of government;
- provide for better understanding of other educational systems;
- improve understanding of our economic system;
- provide a sound educational program for the participant;
- stimulate a greater interest in international relations;
- stimulate an interest in studying the languages of different peoples of the world;
- develop cultural ties with peoples of the world; and
- develop a deeper understanding and appreciation of people from other cultures.

A maximum of three foreign exchange students may be enrolled in the District each school year. Any foreign exchange student living with a District resident family may attend school in this district tuition-free for not more than one school year. Special classroom fees, lunch monies, and special event fees or needs shall be the responsibility of each foreign exchange student, his/her parent/guardian or the host family.

Exchange students admitted under Board policy and District procedures shall have all the rights and privileges accorded to other District students. Exchange students and host families are expected to know and follow all District and school policies and rules.

The foreign exchange program shall operate in accordance with state and federal legal requirements and established District procedures.
