**DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT ALCOHOL AND
OTHER DRUG USE VIOLATIONS**

Any student violating the Board's student alcohol and other drug use policy, including refusal to submit to a breath test, shall be subject to the following disciplinary actions:

FIRST OFFENSE:

1. Suspension from school for up to five (5) school days in accordance with state law and established District procedures.
2. Referral to law enforcement authorities shall occur for all offenses/violations.

The building principal retains the authority to pursue the disciplinary measures outlined below for the first offense if he/she believes the severity of the offense or the circumstances involved in the incident warrants more serious disciplinary action.

SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES:

1. Suspension from school for up to five (5) school days in accordance with state law and established District procedures (If expulsion is considered, the student shall be suspended for up to 15 school days).
2. Possible referral for expulsion.
3. Referral to law enforcement authorities shall occur for all offenses/violations.
