**STUDENT DETENTIONS**

The School Board believes that students who violate school rules and regulations should be disciplined for their actions. Consequences may be in the form of supervised detention periods. Detentions involve the temporary detainment of a student after school or class to complete assigned class work, to do extra work assignments or to serve quiet time.

Students and parents/guardians shall be given advance notice of all detentions to allow for transportation or other arrangements to be made.
