HEAD LICE/NITS

Schools serve as a focal point for the transmission of communicable diseases, including head lice/nits, because schools bring large numbers of students into close daily contact. Control depends upon prompt identification, proper administrative handling of each case, effective treatment and prevention of its spread.

Specific procedures have been developed for the management of head lice and nits in the District. These procedures include providing parent/guardian notification and treatment instructions.

Any student found to have head lice/nits shall be removed from school until proper treatment is provided and verified in accordance with established procedures.
