**STUDENT MOTOR VEHICLE USE**

Students shall be allowed to drive motor vehicles to school and park on school grounds in compliance with state driver and vehicle licensing laws and established District regulations. Students must possess and display a student parking permit and shall only use the parking areas designated for students. Parking without a permit or in undesignated places shall be considered a violation of school rules and may result in disciplinary action. When violations result in the removal of vehicles from school grounds, students or parents/guardians shall be responsible for towing expenses.

The School Board reserves the right to forbid parking on school grounds at any time, to establish annual parking permit fees, and to issue regulations governing the search of vehicles on school grounds in accordance with legal requirements. Permission to drive or park on school grounds may be withdrawn for repeated parking violations and/or unsafe operation of a vehicle on or around school grounds.

The Board assumes no responsibility for damage to or theft of a vehicle, or any item stolen in or on a vehicle parked on school grounds.
