STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Students in the Dodgeland School District shall be informed annually of any available scholarships and awards.

Criteria for District awards and scholarships shall be developed consistent with goals and objectives.

To be eligible for District-administered awards and scholarships, a student must have attended the Dodgeland High School for at least two complete semesters prior to the senior year and complete first semester of the senior year successfully. This restriction may be waived by a majority vote of the high school faculty.

The District will select nominees and alternates for the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship and the Wisconsin Technical Excellence Higher Education Scholarship in accordance with established procedures for those awards.

The Dodgeland School District shall not discriminate in acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
