**STAFF PARTICIPATION IN COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES**

The School Board encourages staff members to participate in community activities and groups that contribute to the improvement and general welfare of the community, state and nation. Such participation helps the community become more informed about school activities and builds community support. Participation helps staff members become more informed about the community, building knowledge about how aspects of the community influence students and about what opportunities are available for students. Staff members are also encouraged to contribute back to the community by taking active roles in cultural, civic and charitable projects.

Staff members who participate in community activities as citizens of the community should recognize that they may be viewed as representatives of the Dodgeland School District. Staff members shall only be authorized to serve as official district representatives when so designated by the Board or the District Administrator.
