PROFESSIONAL STAFF ORIENTATION

The orientation program shall be considered a year-long process for professional staff members new to the district. The program shall be collaboratively developed and delivered by school boards, administrators, teachers, support staff and parents. Coordination shall be provided by the building principals and/or designees.

All staff members are requested to support and assist new staff members. Each new staff member shall be provided a qualified mentor in accordance with state regulations and established district procedures.

The program shall assist new staff members in becoming acquainted with, and adjusted to, the community, school building and district including, but not limited to, Board policies, administrative rules and regulations and the instructional program. Support seminars shall be provided that address state established professional educator standards and the district's mission and goals.
