PERSONAL APPEARANCE OF PROFESSIONAL STAFF

The Dodgeland School Board expects professional staff members to present a well-groomed, professional appearance during scheduled working hours. Employees shall wear appropriate dress that is suitable for a professional work environment and for specific assigned job responsibilities.

The district shall not tolerate dress or other aspects of personal appearance that would be considered inappropriate, unprofessional, unsafe, unhealthy, disruptive, or would otherwise have an adverse affect on the educational environment as determined by district administration.

Employees who violate personal appearance standards shall be required to take corrective action that may include leaving work to change inappropriate clothing. Violations may also result in disciplinary action.

Employees shall be informed of personal appearance standards at the time of hiring.
