STUDENT TEACHERS AND INTERNS

The Dodgeland School Board recognizes its responsibility to improve the quality of teacher training, and the contributions student teachers and interns can make to the District. The quality of teacher training is important to the future of education. For these reasons, the Board authorizes the District Administrator to arrange for the supervision and training of a reasonable number of student teachers and interns. The District Administrator shall be responsible for the development of administrative regulations to guide the student teacher and intern programs and to insure such programs are mutually beneficial.

To assure high quality teaching performance in our schools, student teachers and interns shall be placed with experienced teachers who have demonstrated professional competence. These supervising professional staff members must hold a regular Wisconsin teaching license and have volunteered for the assignment of a student teacher or intern. Supervising staff members must have completed three (3) years of teaching in the District. Assignments require both the approval of the District Administrator and the building principal.

The teacher training institution shall provide liaison personnel who will discuss with the building principal and supervising staff member the broad objectives which the institution believes should be sought for the student. Such personnel are free to visit the classrooms and observe student teachers and interns at work.

Student teachers and interns are expected to develop competency in classroom teaching under the guidance of the supervising staff member. They must obey all rules and regulations that apply to the regular teaching staff, in addition to those specifically expected by the administration and/or teacher training institution. As agents of the District, student teachers and interns shall be covered by the District's liability insurance.
